IPS e.max International course

Lecturer Rob Lynock

This international three day course enables each participant to use all five components of the IPS e.max system. It offers a superb opportunity to get to grips with this extensive and ever expanding all ceramic system.

The training begins early on the first day with detailed waxing, sprueing and investing techniques particular to the IPS e.max Press system. As the range of translucencies and available shades increases so we are discovering new, more effective methods of framework design. This course is at the forefront of the system's latest developments.

The program progresses with the processing of IPS e.max CAD and ZirCAD milled units. We will cover both press to Zirconia with IPS e.max ZirPress and crystallization techniques using "blue blocks".

The remainder of the course is devoted to basic and advanced layering techniques using IPS e.max Ceram. This nano fluorapatite leucite glass ceramic enables us to produce highly aesthetic restorations. Each participant will be given detailed tuition in the use of IPS e.max Ceram.

The program content for this course includes the latest developments for IPS e.max and so it will continue to develop as the system expands.

The course schedule is very busy and as a result ensures that all aspects of the system are covered. Our International Centre for Dental Education (ICDE) is based in Schaan, Liechtenstein and is set amongst the Liechtenstein, Austrian and Swiss Alps. During the daytime the training centre offers the stunning Alpine backdrop and then the evenings are free to relax with fellow course members.

IPS e.max National course (IPS e.max Ceram)

This two day course is available at two venues throughout the UK. The initial section of training covers the preparation of the pre pressed frameworks. During the first morning demonstration of the sprueing, investing and pressing will take place. Further demonstrations will cover use of IPS e.max CAD/ZirCAD and ZirPress.

The focus of this course is IPS e.max Ceram, the nano fluorapatite glass ceramic, which is the main component of the IPS e.max system. With this in mind the majority of this course is devoted to layering techniques in conjunction with both pressed frameworks or Zirconium oxide copings.

The single consistent layering scheme, as well as predictable shade results allow you to offer your dentists and patients highly personalised and natural looking restorations, even for more complex cases independent of the framework material.

IPS Empress / e.max CAD

This one day training course is held at our newly fitted training facility in Leicester. The course program partly focuses on the characterization of IPS Empress milled units using the shade and staining system. Each participant will be offered the opportunity to process their own milled restorations if required.

During the course more advanced layering techniques will be demonstrated to further characterise the milled frameworks. Together with layering and firing of additional ceramics, highly individual, aesthetic restorations can be produced.

As a new addition to this course program we shall be covering the latest developments in the IPS e.max system. All participants will be able to process an IPS e.max CAD unit during the course. The additional tuition will cover staining, glazing and crystallization using the spray glaze materials.

This advanced material delivers high strength and highly aesthetic results easily.
